There is nothing to report: Fire Department, Ambulance, Sheriff, Finance, and Sewer.

Matt Garber attended the meeting to inform the council of the informal quotes CGA received for storm sewer repair. Storm sewer repair topic will be tabled until 5/2/2022.

Randy Daniel reported the shelter house repair is complete.

McCubbin reported for the library. The library is having water runoff issues and mold smell in the basement.
