67.01 Use Sidewalks67.02 Walking in Street

67.03 Hitch Hiking67.04 Pedestrian Crossing

<u>67.01 USE SIDEWALKS.</u> Where sidewalks are provided it shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon an adjacent street.

<u>67.02 WALKING IN STREET.</u> Where sidewalks are not provided, pedestrians shall at all times when walking on or along a street, walk on the left side of the street.

<u>67.03 HITCH HIKING.</u> No person shall stand in the traveled portion of a street for the purpose of soliciting a ride from the driver of any private vehicle.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.331)

<u>67.04 PEDESTRIAN CROSSING.</u> Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway.
